Legal Utopia builds solutions that help people find public access barristers. Our AI tool diagnoses more than 400k legal problems. It uses AI to classify descriptions of legal problems and acts like a search engine for people to understand their legal issues.

Under our free Standard service, we offer one-month contracts to public access barristers. They can upload their profiles and calendars, securely and for free, to our Find and Book a Lawyer services, so that clients can find and book them. Clients can choose their profiles, see live calendar availability, and book and hold virtual calls with public access barristers, or arrange to meet them in person.

All public access barristers pay to unlock a client. Once a client is unlocked, public access barristers are given free access to all other clients who may book for the next calendar month. We also offer further marketing under our Premium package for a fee.

In 2020, we were a member of the LawTechUK sandbox, received press coverage, and an Innovate UK-backed grant. We have since launched our app and web portal, and are talking to partners abroad.
